****DAY 1:** We travel via Geelong to Torquay - stopping to shop at Quiksilver and Rip Curl - before continuing on to the world famous Bells Beach. Hugging the coastline we stop to view koalas, pass through the seaside town of Lorne, then break for lunch at Apollo Bay. In the afternoon we travel through the magnificent cool temperate rainforest of the Otway National Park, spend time at the awesome Otway Fly (a 25 metre high elevated tree top walk) and view sunset at the Twelve Apostles. Tonight we stay in the coastal township of Princetown. (L,D)

DAY 2: This morning we continue along the western end of the Great Ocean Road viewing London Bridge, Bay of Martyrs and Bay of Islands and take a break at Warrnambool; where you may view whales (seasonal). We then head inland to the Grampians National Park. We finish the day with a walk to The Balconies & Reeds Lookout before arriving at our overnight accommodation at Halls Gap. (B,L,D)

DAY 3: This morning we hike to the bottom of MacKenzie Falls & Hollow Mountain and then head west, stopping for lunch at Horsham. We continue through the agricultural district of Victoria and into South Australia, view rare White Western Grey Kangaroos at Bordertown and cross the mighty Murray River, before arriving into the city of Adelaide. (B,L)

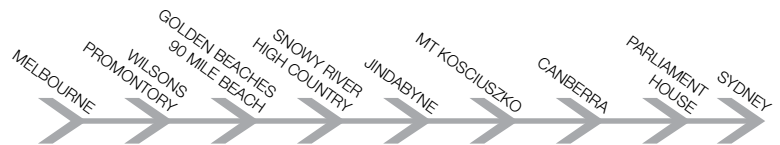


****DAY 1:** Leaving Melbourne we head out to Wilsons Promontory National Park. Walk along gleaming beaches, hike along amazing granite rock formations and learn about coastal flora and native wildlife. In the afternoon we travel to the coastal town of Lakes Entrance. Here, we're at the Gateway to the Gippsland Lakes and Australia's longest beach - Ninety Mile Beach. (D)

DAY 2: This morning we begin our journey into Snowy River Country. In the afternoon we climb high into the Australian Alps to the village of Thredbo (October to May). In Thredbo we catch the express chairlift towards the "Roof of Australia". You can walk to the summit of Mt Kosciuszko, which is Australia's highest mountain, or to the viewing point. The chairlift is your own expense. In ski season - from June to the end of September - we stay in Jindabyne. During winter, we've got time to play in the snow at the ski resort of Perisher/Smiggins (optional toboggan hire or snow tube at own expense). (B,D)

DAY 3: Travel to Canberra, Australia's capital city, where the Prime Minister hangs out. We'll take you to the top of Mt Ainslie so you can see for yourself how a custom-made capital city was built. We also do a tour of Parliament House, then check out a few embassies and see other city highlights before travelling on to Sydney. (B)

DAY 1: From Melbourne we head direct to the Grampians National Park, one of the world's oldest and most spectacular mountain ranges. Here we hike to Boroka Lookout. After a short stop in Halls Gap for lunch (own expense) we continue onto the Jaws of Death and Balconies Lookout. Visit Mackenzie Falls and Brambuk Aboriginal Cultural Centre. Overnight is at Halls Gap (D).

DAY 2: Start the morning with a 'heart-pumping' hike to The Pinnacle. We then head south to Warrnambool for a chance to view whales (seasonal). Onto the famous Great Ocean Road where we visit the Bay of Islands, Bay of Martyrs, London Bridge and Loch Ard Gorge. Tonight we enjoy watching the sunset of the Twelve Apostles. Stay overnight in the coastal township of Princetown (B,L,D).

DAY 3: This morning climb Gibsons Steps, and then enjoy a tree top elevated walk at the Otway Fly. Then onto the seaside town of Apollo Bay for a quick lunch stop. Hugging the coastline we pass through Lorne, stop in search of koalas, visit world famous Bells Beach, and then a shopping break at Torquay; home of Quiksilver and Rip Curl brands. After grabbing a bargain, we head back to Melbourne arriving early evening (B,L).
